**Broomfield Council on the Arts and Humanities (BCAH)** offered for us the opportunity to give a demonstration on how to create arts using Recyclables at the "**Brighton Collectibles**" in the Flatirons Mall. It also went well. Then BCAH offered another opportunity to participate in one of their musical programs on Summer Sundays, and on August the 5th they gave us a tent, a table and chairs. So we need money from other sources. **BCAH** is an organization that helps people like us. If we become members, we can get grants through them but we have to pay some money. I think it is worth it and we should put some effort in this direction. I investigated **Coors**, and **Colorado Grants**, but they require having the 501c3 status. I will keep looking for other sources. I need your help to find other places to get help from.
