Tools needed for all the demonstrations:

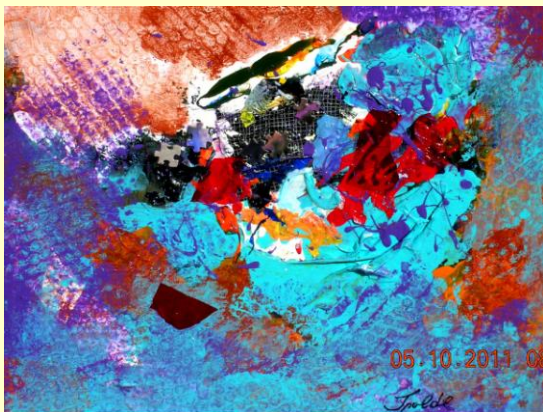
1. Board or canvas to work on
