The grant progress is going slowly. Misty created a plan and outlined EAC's needs in order to request money from several different organizations. Next is the writing of the proposal and submitting process, but she got stuck on a grant application through the Government because they requested a DUNS number. DUNS stands for **Data Universal Numbering System**. It is a 9 digit number for profit and non-profit organizations interested in applying for a U.S. government grant. But the dead line for the grant application is too soon and we don't have enough time to get the DUNS number, so we have to postpone this application. In the mean time, Misty will apply for a grant from organizations that do not require the DUNS number.
