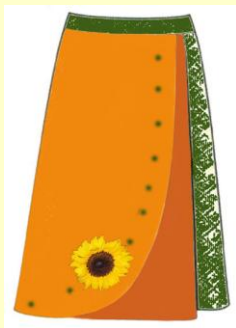
Wednesday, November 17 2014.
