2. Water colors or acrylics - bright colors
3. Brushes
4. Two (2) containers for water
5. Paper towels
6. **Pencil**
7. **Ruler**
8. **Exacto or craft knife**
9. **All-purpose glue**
10. Invisible thread or fine fishing line
